



PURPOSE

Furever Pet Rescue (FPR) is a registered NPC operating in the North Coast to rescue and re-home abandoned and abused dogs and cats and other domestic animals.

In an attempt to curb this problem at its roots, we are embarking on a pet sterilisation and education program called SAVE (Sterilise-Assist-Vaccinate-Educate). This program will target high-risk areas along the North Coast. To maximise the effectiveness of these efforts, we will target four areas over a three-year period. This is outlined below.

TARGETTED AREAS & DATES (last Sunday each quarter where possible but dates may change)

Year 1:

- 28 February 2016 - Shayamona
- 4 June 2016 - Groutville
- 20 August 2016 - Shakaskraal
- 27 November 2016 - Etete

Year 2:

- 26 February 2017 - Shayamona
- 4 June 2017 - Groutville
- 20 August 2017 – Shakaskraal/Nkobongo
- 12 November 2017 - Etete

Year 3:

- 11 March 2018 - Shayamoya
- 27 May 2018 - Groutville
- 26 August 2018 – Shakaskraal/Nkobongo
- 11 November 2018 – Etete

APPROACH & LOGISTICS

A pilot project was held on 23 August 2015 in Etete. We were able to:

- Sterilise 30 dogs
- Sterilise 3 cats
- Vaccinate 75 dogs
- Vaccinate 10 cats
- Provide food parcels for same.

Mange and/or flea/tick treatment was given to approximately 1/3 of the dogs seen. Ideally all puppies and dogs seen would be given flea and tick treatment as this is a huge problem in high-risk areas such as those we are targeting. All puppies and dogs were given de-worming tablets.

We expect to achieve an increase of 5-6% on those numbers in 2016 at each of the four targeted areas. We further expect those numbers to increase by approximately 10% in 2017 and by approximately 20% in 2018 as awareness of the project grows.

Therefore targets are as follows:

2016 – 4 program days

- Sterilise 130 dogs
- Vaccinate, de-worm, give flea/tick treatment and provide food parcels for 320 dogs
- Sterilise 12 cats
- Vaccinate, de-worm, give flea/tick treatment and provide food parcels for 50 cats
- Provide mange treatment for 100 dogs

2017 – 4 program days

- Sterilise 140 dogs
- Vaccinate, de-worm, give flea/tick treatment and provide food parcels for 355 dogs
- Sterilise 16 cats
- Vaccinate, de-worm, give flea/tick treatment and provide food parcels for 55 cats
- Provide mange treatment for 110 dogs

2018 – 4 program days

- Sterilise 170 dogs
- Vaccinate, de-worm, give flea/tick treatment and provide food parcels for 425 dogs
- Sterilise 20 cats
- Vaccinate, de-worm, give flea/tick treatment and provide food parcels for 65 cats
- Provide mange treatment for 140 dogs

Another crucial component of SAVE is “Education” whereby a volunteer will give talks in the primary and secondary schools in the target area the week leading up to the clinic date. The children will be given information on how to care for their pets, what not to do to their pets and the dates and times for the upcoming clinic.
